## Policies

### Payment:

- Private tours are \$214.00 per 1 hour **PLUS** the cost of admissions to the Haida Gwaii Museum. There is no tax on the private tour but there is 5% GST on the admission fee.
- To confirm your tour booking there is a **non-refundable** deposit of \$100.00
- **The Haida Heritage Centre requires that the remaining balance be paid no later than the day of your tour.**
- Invoices can be paid via credit card, debit, cheque etc.

### Private Tours:

- Private Tours are a minimum of 1 hour.
- Please ensure you are at least 15 minutes early. If you are going to be late, please call ahead or the tour will be cancelled or start without you.
- We have 4 private tours available:
  - **Monumental Pole Tour** - will cover the background of the Haida Heritage Centre and Haida Gwaii Museum, the Xuuaji Naay pole in the Welcome House, 6 poles outside, Carving House, Display Model, and Luu Taa.
  - **The Museum Tour** - will walk you through the Temporary Gallery (if available), take you through the Supernatural Room, explain the rising of the water levels, a quick overview of the timeline, talk about the weaving and argillite collection and discuss the Skidegate Haida Immersion Programs, along with many topics that will be brought up during the discussions.
  - **Weaving Tour** – Learn about the origins of traditional and modern Haida weaving, different textiles and styles, and patterns and their representations.
  - **Canoe Tour** – Learn of the main styles of Haida Luu (canoe), how their made, and the purposes they held. Also learn of ancient Haida trading roots, eligibility for war canoes, paddles and more!

We the Haida people live and abide by the 4 Haida Laws and we ask you, our visitor to conduct yourselves in the same matter while visiting us and Haida Gwaii.

### **Yahguudang (Respect)**

*All acts must be done with respect*

Respect the space – The Haida Heritage Centre is on the ancestral village site of Kay Llnagaay – Sealion Town.

Respect the people – The Haida Heritage Centre staff are all Haida and knowledgeable about their history.

### **Ad Kyaanang (To ask first)**

*All acts must be done with consent*

Any questions regarding Haida culture, people, or the Haida Heritage Centre, please feel free to ask at any time.
